Mae hyn gryn dipyn yn uwch na'r cyfartaledd cenedlaethol.

Dear Parents and Carers of year 6 pupils of our cluster

We look forward to welcoming year 6 pupils to Llanhari next Wednesday the 4<sup>th</sup> of October. You will see from the attached leaflet that this is the first of three transition days for the pupils during this academic year. We have planned an exciting day of Expressive Arts activities for the pupils and during the remainder of the visits your children will have the opportunity to get a taste of the various subjects on offer at the secondary department at Ysgol Llanhari, get to know pupils in their year group and the staff.

It was wonderful to welcome so many of you as current Barcud parents and prospective parents from the cluster to the school during the Summer Term and since then, we have celebrated many successes in the A level and GCSE exams. All the pupils who wished to go to University were successful in obtaining a place, so we are very proud of them as they take their next steps in their educational career. The GCSE Summer 2023 results were excellent with pupils across the ability range succeeding to reach their potential. The teachers are able to get the best out of each individual, whatever their ability and this is clearly reflected in the results. You can be confident that your child is in good hands in September! The fact that 26.5% of the pupils managed to gain 5 or more A\*-A grades is particularly noteworthy. 87% of the pupils gained A\*-C grades in five or more subjects and of this total, 70% of the pupils gained at least ten A\*-C GCSE grades. This is considerably higher than the national average.

We were very pleased that some of you as parents attended our coffee afternoon this week. All year 6 parents are welcome to contact us if you would like to visit the school before you decide on the next step for your child. We will be very pleased to answer any questions you may have, especially if you are concerned about Welsh-medium secondary education for your child if you do not speak Welsh or if you are concerned about your child's wellbeing and his/her academic ability through the medium of Welsh. We are here to help you and your child and ease your worries if you have questions. We pride ourselves on being an inclusive school and that our support for our pupils is excellent!
