I am extremely proud of this report as the inspectors had a very favourable impression of the school when they visited us in October of this year. This report recognizes the school's many strengths which includes our work as a cluster of schools and I am sure that when you read it, you will be very proud of being a prospective member of *Teulu Llanhari*. The following are specifically identified as the school's strengths:

- An inclusive and caring community - pupils are polite, respectful and feel safe
- Teaching is a strength – teachers create a supportive environment with purposeful activities and clear instructions
- A rich curriculum – promoting international languages, health and wellbeing and numerous educational visits
- Pupils' behaviour – they are extremely polite and respectful, with a clear willingness to collaborate and discuss
- High quality pastoral care and support for pupils with Additional Learning Needs,
- Clear leadership – Headteacher and Leadership team have a solid vision based on the values of *Community, Welshness and Progress (Cymuned, Cymreictod a Chynnydd)*

During the last few weeks it has been confirmed that Willmot Dixon Contractors were successful in the tender process to build a new school for Llanhari. We have not met with them thus far but discussions with our link 21st Century Schools' officer from the Local Authority are ongoing. We hope to be able to share further plans with you as prospective parents towards the end of the Spring Term. It's an exciting time at Ysgol Llanhari!
