

Llangrannog Trip 19th – 21st June

Dear Parent / Carer

The bus will be leaving school for Llangrannog at approximately **9:15a.m.** from St John's Road on Monday 19th.

The Lolfa (access via the junior yard) will be open during the morning from 8:15am to receive bags. Could you ensure that all bags/sleeping bags are clearly labelled with your child's name and that they are **able to carry their own bag/case**. All pupils will be travelling on 1 bus and storage space is limited therefore cases/bags must be of a **reasonable size** i.e. weekend bag/case.

Remember to pack a rain coat showers have been forecasted for Tuesday.

Any medication, asthma pumps or travel sickness tablets should be given to Miss Downes / Miss Hughes and not packed in the bags. You should also fill in the school's medical form explaining what dosage should be given and how often it should be administered.

There is a shop in Llangrannog selling a variety of items and £15 is more than enough money to take on the weekend. Could you please put £5 in 3 separate labelled envelopes (coins if possible) to ensure that they have money to spend each day – please can the money be brought to school on Friday. School staff will be responsible for the money, and they will give an envelope to each child daily.

Llangrannog and the school have a no mobile phone policy, and we also kindly ask that the children leave expensive objects at home, in case they get broken or mislaid.

All pupils are expected to follow school and Llangrannog rules – **if these rules are broken pupils will not participate in the activities and parents may have to come and collect their child from the camp.**

Finally, I would like to thank the teachers who are giving up their evenings (unpaid) to take the children to Llangrannog, so that they can enjoy a fun-filled 3 days through the medium of Welsh. Without them this trip would not be possible.

The children should arrive back to school on Wednesday afternoon at approximately 4:00p.m.
